OUC Stanton Energy Plant Tour

The Orlando Utilities Commission (OUC) is a municipally-owned public utility providing water and electric service in greater Orlando, Florida. OUC is the second largest locally owned electric utility in Florida and the 16th largest in the nation serving over 250,000 customers.

MACF members will tour the OUC Curtis H. Stanton Energy Center (SEC). This energy center, with its iconic cooling towers in east Orange County, is the most diverse generation site in Florida featuring natural gas, landfill gas and coal generation, as well as a nearly 6 Megawatt solar farm. With a generation capacity of 1,850 MWs, it is also one of the most reliable and environmentally responsible power stations in the nation.

In this tour, members will get a brief overview of the plant logistics, water supply, fuel supply, fuel diversification, and outage strategy. In addition we will do a tour of the main control room demonstrating the technology advances within the past 20 years.

Please note you must bring a valid ID with you to this tour and note that any loose dangling clothing, jewelry or unnecessary metal should not be worn.
